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Who to contact at GGS?

The purpose of the following information is to advise you of the person or people you should contact for a particular concern you may have.

The most effective way to contact Guildford Grammar School staff is through their email. The email address for all staff is in the format of firstname.surname@ggs.wa.edu.au. The address for Mr Brad Evans, for example, would read: brad.evans@ggs.wa.edu.au

Staff can also be contacted by phone by calling the main switch board on **9377 9222** and then being directed to the appropriate department.

NOTE: it is likely you will have to leave a voice message on most phones.

Curriculum

You can access the academic program, resources and marks book for each subject through SEQTA Engage, for which you will be provided your own login details. Your child can also access the student version, SEQTA Learn.

If you have a particular concern regarding your child's academic progress in a particular subject, you should initially contact their individual teacher. The teacher can provide up to date information on how your child is progressing in the subject as well as the class' learning program.

The Head of Faculty is another person who you can contact to discuss any matters associated with their learning area.
