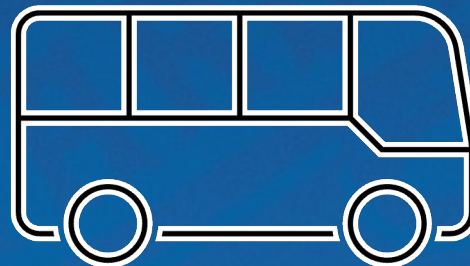
Important Information

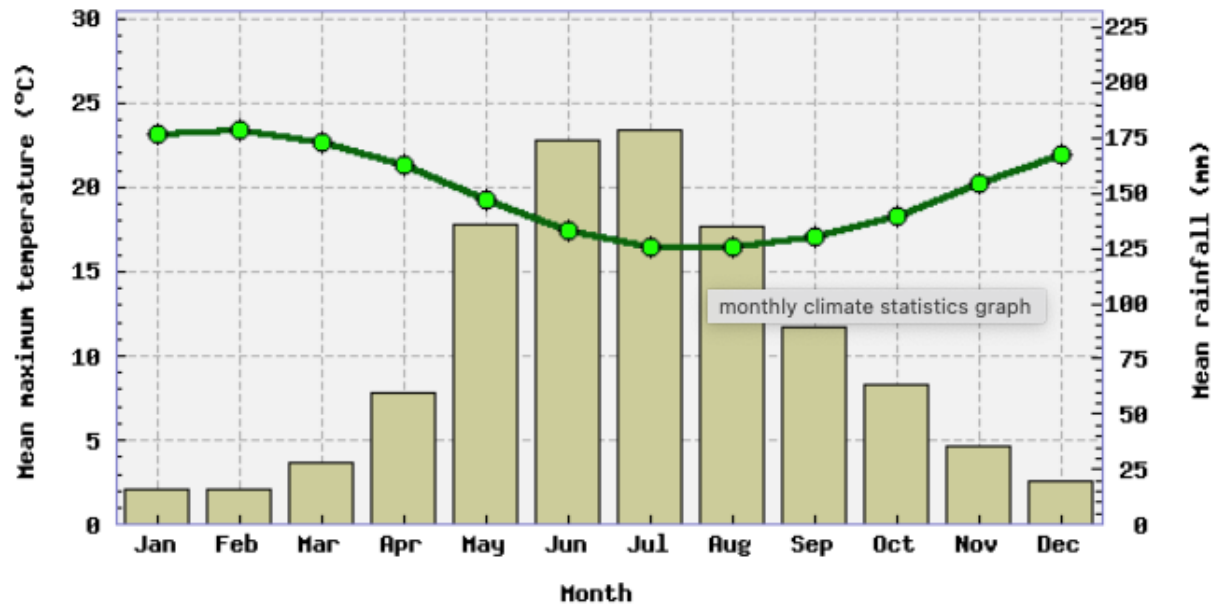

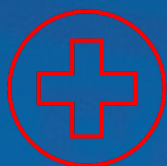
